5. Special Event/ Sign Waiver Request — Historical Car Club of PA – DCCC – Fall Meet

10/15/2023 – On a motion by Commissioner Longacre, and seconded by Commissioner Lucas to approve the request of the Historical Car Club of PA, to hold their annual Fall Meet at the Delaware County Community College on October 15, 2023, subject to the following conditions:

1. DCCC Event participants, vendor and visitors shall be restricted to using the College's main entrance on Media Line Road for arriving and Newtown Street Road (SR 252) for leaving the event. Unless the Marple Police Department finds these restrictions would cause traffic problems. The Car Club shall note these restrictions in their event advertisements.
2. The Club shall contract with the Marple Township Police Department for 1 officer for the event at the Community College
3. The Township Code Enforcement Department shall monitor the event for compliance with the Township's noise ordinance. The Club shall agree to immediately remove any show vehicle or presenter from the event who violates the noise ordinance.
4. The Club agrees to advertise restrictions on noise to all participants and spectators and prohibit displayed vehicles from running or revving engines during the event.
5. The Club agrees to inform participants and spectators that citations for noise violations will be issued to anyone violating the noise regulations.
6. Event advertising signage is limited to the event properties and must be approved by the Code Enforcement Department subject to the provisions outlined in Section 300-115 of the Township Cod, the vote being unanimous. (5-0)

6. Special Event/ Sign Waiver Request — Historical Car Club of PA – Massey

House – Frostbite Run 11-23-2023 – On a motion by Commissioner Lucas and seconded by Commissioner Knapp to approve the request of the Historical Car Club of PA, to hold their annual Frostbite Run at the Thomas Massey House on November 23, 2023 subject to the provisions outlined in Section 300-115 of the Township Code, the vote being unanimous. (5-0)

7. Special Event/Sign Waiver Request St. Luke Greek Orthodox Church – Greek

Affair September 15, 16, and 17, 2023 – On a motion by Commissioner Longacre, and seconded by Commissioner Lucas to approve the request of the St. Luke Greek Church pursuant to Chapter 300, Section 300-115, Special Events, of the Township Code, to conduct their Greek Affair to be held on September 15, 16, and 17, 2023 subject to the provisions outlined in Section 300-115 of the Township Code and to permit limited event advertising signage on the property and on designated Township properties will also be permitted but shall be erected no sooner than 15 days prior to the event and as approved by the Code Enforcement Department subject to the provisions outlined in Section 300-115, the vote being unanimous.
